

Supporting Foodbanks in the Diocese of London during COVID 19 outbreak



Some guidance from Trussell Trust and local foodbanks for those who want to give during Coronavirus Crisis

- Check for what they need before buying. Most foodbanks have websites and/or twitter feeds they keep updated with requests (see table below).
- Foodbanks are struggling to get food because of panic buying and lack of supplies. If you can, please buy for them as well whenever you go to shop, and share what you have rather than stockpile. We trust that God will provide our daily bread!
- If you are healthy and already registered as a volunteer, please offer to step up. They are losing volunteers to self-isolation, and with many of them being older (some 70+) they anticipate that will only get worse. Having volunteers and that can mean the difference between staying open and closing. There may in future days be particular need for those with cars who can deliver.
- Drop off when/where they ask for it. Many foodbanks have supermarket collection points; otherwise try and get to prearranged drop off time/venue. Be prepared to leave bags at the door. It's not as helpful for them just turning up on spec – as there may not be staff to receive your donation. Some foodbanks will receive online shops to their warehouses/stores, but please check with them first.
- If you need to contact your local foodbank as to where to drop off, try and use email or on twitter if you can, as phone calls take up a lot of staff time and they're inundated
- Money is great if you can't get out, or can't get food. Donation information for each foodbank is listed where they accept it.
- This is a rapidly changing situation and many foodbanks are preparing for unprecedented demand at a time when they have the least resource to draw on. **So please, be kind. They'll be doing their best and beyond.**
